The meeting was called to order by Regional Director Brad Jarvis at 10:05 a.m. Brad announced that tournament information will be available on line the week of February 20<sup>th</sup>. This will include the first draft of the schedule. Teams will have one week to email Brad to request a schedule change. The final schedule will be posted the week of March 5<sup>th</sup>.

Sherry Pomeroy announced that we have 73 teams registered. The challenge breakdown is as follows:

- Challenge A - 6 teams
- Challenge B - 13 teams
- Challenge C - 26 teams
- Challenge D - 16 teams
- Challenge E - 6 teams
- Rising Stars - 5 teams

Site Director Claudia Corbe explained that we will have two registration sites, one at Beeghly and the other in Kilcawley. Kids Rulz, Back at You and Inside Dimension will be held in Beeghly and How'd that Happen, On safari and Rising stars will compete in Kilcawley. Instant Challenge will again be held in DeBartolo Hall. A discussion ensued concerning lunch options for appraisers, and Claudia will check for information about the possibility of giving vouchers for Arbys as well as additional options other than box lunches.

Brad discussed the fact the Destination Imagination no longer gives medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place, but have certificates instead. The group agreed that the children really like the medals. Cathy Coen announced that the medals can be ordered with the trophies from C & S Trophy for 2.00 each. Awards will cost a total of approximately \$600 per year.

Due to unforeseen circumstances, we are in need of Challenge Masters for Challenge A and Challenge D. Several people mentioned possible replacements and will check with these people and get back to Brad as soon as possible. Heidi Davis is the new Challenge Master for Challenge 8, Kids Rulz, and Deb Hagg is the Challenge Master for Instant Challenge.

John Kuzma announced that the deadline for program ads has passed and no more will be accepted. He also informed us that he has found a photographer for the tournament.

Lois Thornton distributed a list of volunteers for the day of the tournament and their assignments and asked for any changes that may need to be made.


Baskets for the raffle need to be brought to the March 4<sup>th</sup> meeting. The baskets will be displayed on the first floor in Kilcawley the day of the tournament.

Appraiser training is March 4<sup>th</sup> at Western Reserve United Methodist Church. Board members who are able to help that day are asked to arrive by 7: 15 a.m. Registration will begin at 8:00 a.m.

Cathy Coen made a motion to pay a stipend of \$1,000 to the Regional Director each year, to be disbursed after the tournament is over and all expenses have been paid. Claudia Corbe seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 11:40 a.m.
